2. Where we get your personal information from

We collect your information from you directly or it will be generated in the course of you providing the services.

3. Who we share information with

We use third party providers to store / host your personal information. These third parties act as our Data Processors. These Data Processers process your personal data within the UK and the EEA.

We may share your personal information with other third parties where we have a legal obligation to do so. For example, where a regulatory body or an insurer requests your information.

4. Your data protection rights

Your right to data portability - You have the right to ask that we transfer the personal data you gave us to another organisation, or to you, in certain circumstances.

Your right to withdraw consent – When we use consent as our lawful basis you have the right to withdraw your consent.

You don't usually need to pay a fee to exercise your rights. If you make a request, we have one calendar month to respond to you.
